On the 31st July 2019, Pakton Group proudly announced the release of the Jumbo (JMB) Electric Fence Energiser series at a Sheep Technology Field Day in Goondiwindi, QLD. Consisting of three models, each producing a stunning 46J of stored energy, the JMB series is the most powerful and feature-rich range of electric fence energisers Pakton has released to date, taking the lead as the world's largest IP Energiser(R)!

While the JMB was specifically designed for boundary and exclusion fencing, the series is also well suited to any large permanent electric fencing application. At time of publication, the JMB range will only be available to Australian customers in conjunction with the Solar Electric Fence Station (PTE2500).

Each JMB unit produces up to 46 Joules (stored) and is designed and manufactured in Australia.

We are very pleased to see our products flourishing on an international scale, and hope to share similar news again with you next year!




Cloud Router version 2


Team Dougall Sponsorship Update

However, this misfortune gave Brooke an opportunity for Brooke to focus on "Chester" and hopefully get him to his first two-star event at the end of the season.

There were times when "Chester" seriously challenged Brooke and then there were times when he was a little superstar. The QLD International 3DE saw them complete their first one-star long format together. One of only six combinations to go, clear and under time they placed a respectable 16th out of 50 starters and earned themselves the necessary qualification to move up to two-star!

Fig Tree Pocket was the first event "My Locky" competed in after his accident, and he did not disappoint! The next event we took him to Toowoomba International Event to test things a little more. Leading after the dressage, a clear showjumping round kept them in the lead. Crosscountry day was exciting and they galloped around the course, jumping like a pro they came in with only a couple of time faults. Finishing in second, we could not have been happier.



We made the decision to step both horses up to the next level at the last event for the season. "My Locky" competed in the three-star class and "Chester" stepped up to two-star at the recent Tambourine Equestrian CNC event. "My Locky" jumped a lovely clear cross country round to finish in 5th place. Chester, however, was a superstar! The two-star course had quite a few fences the little fellow had not had to face up to before. He did not disappoint, finishing his season with a beautiful clear round and almost on time. The smile on Brooke's face said it all, and it is the reason we keep going even when things get tough and do not always go to plan.
